I've attached a link to a video about Shin's life—which, if you have an hour to spare, is well worth watching.

My daughter Katherine and I are participating in a volunteer-based medical brigade, January 7th-13th, 2016, through the University of Virginia's Chapter of Global Medical and Dental Brigades in Honduras. We will set up a five-day medical clinic performing basic medical and dental exams in rural Honduras, where volunteering U.S. physicians are partnered with local physicians. Students from the University of Virginia and Johns Hopkins University will partner to obtain vitals from patients, observe consult, and to inspire and inform community members to instill value in healthy habits. My daughter participated in a similar brigade last January to Nicaragua and found it very rewarding.

We are planning to spend about three days in El Progresso with Shin after our brigade is finished—we are still working out the details—I will get back to you once I know, as I would be glad to take something to Shin for the children from Immanuel if that is possible.
