"Know your sheep by name, carefully attend to your flocks." Proverbs 27:23

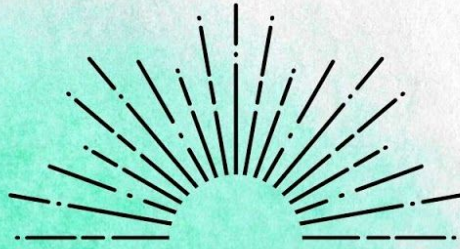
