## (Virtual) Christmas Tag Trees Arrive Soon!

Our annual Christmas Tag Tree arrives soon -- and for the first time, it comes to you virtually. This year, we will ask IPC members and friends to select tags via SignUpGenius, which we hope to share by mid-November.

Please consider providing Christmas gifts and gift cards for the children of Bright Beginnings, Children of Mine, Falls Church-McLean Children's Center, Mary House, SHARE, and families identified by Garden Memorial Presbyterian. We have many children to help this challenging year, and your generosity will ensure these children have gifts for the Christmas holiday.

Due to this holiday season's unique circumstances, we've worked closely with each organization to determine how we can best (and safely) bring holiday cheer to the families!

Since this year will entail a slightly different operation, we have included a list of questions/answers to introduce this year's Tag Tree effort:

### How do I sign up for Tag Tree this year?

A SignUpGenius will be available by mid-November 2020 via the Friday E-Presence.

### What gifts should I buy?

Due to this year's coronavirus pandemic, we have worked closely with each organization to determine how we can best help their identified families during this unique holiday season. When you are considering donations via the SignUpGenius, you will be able to see whether the organization is requesting gifts as normal or is asking for gift cards for all children/families. More specific guidance regarding gift selection will be available via the SignUpGenius.

### How should I prepare gifts this year?

As in prior years, we will ask that you wrap gifts prior to drop-off and collection by CS&A. In normal years, CS&A has included sticky labels as part of each tag on the tree to attach to each wrapped gift; this helps track gifts and ensure they make their way to the correct organization and family. Because this year's sign up will be virtual and we will be unable to distribute these labels, we will include specific instructions for labeling via the SignUpGenius.

### How will gifts be collected by CS&A? When and where will they be collected?

Similar to previous years, we have scheduled a day for IPC members and friends to deliver pre-wrapped gifts to the Immanuel campus. *This year's collection date is currently scheduled for Sunday, December 13.* Throughout that day, Immanuel and CS&A committee volunteers will collect gifts outdoors (practicing proper health and social distancing guidance) before delivering to each organization.

Specific details regarding drop-off location, timing, and expectations will be available via the SignUpGenius and subsequent E-Presence communications. Date and instructions are subject to change with changes to the public health situation; CS&A will be in touch with any schedule updates should they be necessary.
