Who We Are Looking For:

We seek a Spirit-inspired musician who leads with joy, loves sharing music, creates community, and fosters openness, and who is gracious, welcoming, patient, and kind. Our Director of Music should be in tune with the crucial role that music plays in Reformed worship, nurture participation, and creatively imagine possibilities that engage our senses, body and soul. We hope this person will exhibit playful energy with the ability to teach and be taught and respond to changing situations to help us grow together.

To realize this vision, our Director of Music should demonstrate the following qualifications and attributes:

- have a bachelor’s degree in music, master’s preferred, and a minimum five years’ experience in managing a program similar to ours in terms of quality, scope and complexity,
- be a talented organist, pianist and sight-reader, spanning styles from classical to contemporary,
- be proficient in a variety of musical traditions, genres, and instruments,
- have good organizational skills,
- have skills and/or basic understanding of current worship technologies (video, audio and streaming),
- be committed to building good relationships within the staff and congregation,
- be a collaborative team player,
- be eager to integrate music into the entire church experience,
- be inviting to, and recruiting, all who wish to participate in our music program,
- be a visionary, willing to try new ideas and take creative risks,
- have the ability to arrange, compose, and improvise (preferred).

Responsibilities of the Director of Music Include:

Worship Planning

- Collaborate with the Pastors, staff, and congregation to plan and lead meaningful worship services
- Serve as a member of the Music Committee and attend other committee meetings as needed
- Plan vocal and instrumental music for all worship services in collaboration with the Pastors.
- Work with the Communications Coordinator to provide information necessary for the church bulletin and other church communications

Worship Leadership

- Manage church ensembles for both the morning and evening services, from choral direction to band coordination and/or leadership, with regular rehearsals for all ensembles
- Nurture broad participation of volunteers from the congregation in the music ministry
- Provide opportunities for intergenerational music presentations
- Invite guest musicians to enrich worship as needed
- Lead music for special services, such as Lenten Vespers, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Christmas Eve
- Provide and/or coordinate music at weddings and funerals

Administration

- Manage the Music Program within the annual church budget
- Manage up to two music staff members including activities, oversight, and annual reviews
- Oversee the maintenance of instruments, musical library, and worship equipment
- Coordinate with Lively-Fulcher to ensure scheduled and as-needed organ maintenance is completed

Other Duties as Assigned could include but not limited to:

- Plan and direct voice and bell choir tours
- Coordinate visiting choirs and other musical presentations such as a church musical night event
- Coordinate with other organizations in the area for combined musical outreach,
- Attend musical group conventions with program participants, such as a bell choir
